The test will consist of multiple choice questions as well as open-ended questions and will be focused mainly on the Laws of Chess, but all listed topics may appear there as well. A practical task or exercise can also be part of the overall exam. All the documents (apart from the Laws of Chess) can be used during the test in printed form.
